



Design a flowerbed competition

Christchurch Council have kindly donated to us three flower beds (located opposite the Police Station in Barrack Road) to celebrate and advertise Scouting's centenary in 2007. One flower bed will be used for the scout logo; one will be used for the centenary celebration logo. But what to put in the third bed? That's where you come in!

A competition to design the third flower bed is now launched with five categories - Beavers, Cubs, Scouts, Explorers and 18+

Remember to keep your design simple so that it can be easily adapted to form a flowerbed.

Designs should be submitted to the District Commissioner on a single sheet of A4 landscape paper or card no later than 31st March 2006. Please put your name, age, Scout Group, address and telephone number on the back of your entry!

Entries will then be judged by a special panel and winners of each category will receive a special certificate and centenary mug. The overall winner will receive a certificate, mug and will get their design made into the flower bed in 2007.
